## DIFFERENCES BETWEEN CIVIL & CRIMINAL COURTS

## CIVIL COURT

- REGULATES NON-CRIMINAL RIGHTS & DUTIES.
- COVERS DISPUTES BETWEEN PEOPLE, SUCH AS FAMILY, CONTRACT, PROPERTY, OR INJURY-RELATED CLAIMS.
- SEVENTH AMENDMENT
  GUARANTEES A JURY TRIAL IN
  CASES INVOLVING MORE
  THAN TWENTY DOLLARS.

#### **EXAMPLES:**

- PURDUE PHARMA OPIOID LITIGATION (2020s)
- MACPHERSON V. BUICK (1916)
- SIOUX CITY & PACIFIC RAILROAD CO. V. STOUT (1873)

### CRIMINAL COURT

- BEHAVIOR PUNISHABLE AS A PUBLIC OFFENSE.
- CRIMES COVER EVERYTHING FROM SHOPLIFTING TO MURDER.
- THE GOVERNMENT DECIDES TO BRING CHARGES AGAINST SOMEONE IN COURT.
- PUNISHMENT MAY INCLUDE IMPRISONMENT.
