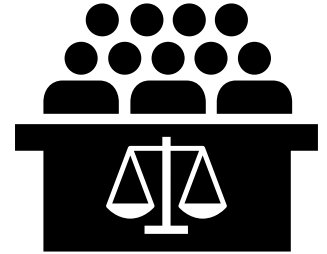

- **Supreme Court vacancy occurs.**
- **The full Senate votes to confirm the nomination.**
- **The Senate Judiciary Committee holds public hearings about the nominee.**
- **The President announces their nomination and formally submits the nomination to the Senate.**
- **The Senate Judiciary Committee votes to determine what recommendation to report to the full Senate.**
