IMPORTANCE OF *MARBURY V. MADISON*

- ESTABLISHED THE PRINCIPLE OF JUDICIAL REVIEW.
- THIS MEANT THE SUPREME COURT COULD DECLARE A LAW UNCONSTITUTIONAL.
- STRENGTHENED THE POWER OF OUR FEDERAL COURTS IN THE PROCESS.

NOTABLE SUPREME COURT CASES

- *BROWN V. BOARD OF EDUCATION* (1954)
 - HELPED TO DESEGREGATE OUR SCHOOLS.
- *LOVING V. VIRGINIA* (1967)
 - LEGALIZED INTERRACIAL MARRIAGE ACROSS OUR COUNTRY.
- *MIRANDA V. ARIZONA* (1966)
 - POLICE MUST INFORM SUSPECTS OF THEIR RIGHTS BEFORE QUESTIONING.
