In 2019, the Legislature created a registry to help veterans who are victims of toxic burn pits exposure. Now, it needs funding to operate.

Two bills will fund the registry without affecting the state budget.

HB 3953 allows you to make a **voluntary contribution** to the burn pits registry fund when you apply for a handgun license.

HB 3957 creates **specialty Texas license plates** to honor veterans wounded by toxic burn pits and fund the registry.
